A Summer Weekend In Ohio

It was a hot summer weekend at the end of July 2012 when people started arriving from across the nation. Many came by plane while others made the trek to Columbus by car.

They brought coolers packed full of roses for the annual competition of miniature and mini-flora specimens. They also came with reeds, and weeds, and sticks, and stones, and other props used in the creation of rose arrangements.



While horticulture folks had visions of opening that special bloom to produce a perfect specimen, arrangers concentrated on creative ways to connect line, mass, and texture into a pleasing presentation to the eyes of the judges.

The Double-Tree Hilton Hotel on the city's north side was the venue and Friday night's welcome reception renewed old

friendships and started new ones.

People were looking at Whit

Wells' table filled with roses
for sale. It was easy to
overhear conversations
about who wasn't in the
room, who didn't attend the
14th Annual ARS National

and Rose Show, The 2012 event

was sponsored by the Columbus Rose Club, The Delaware Area Rose Society and The Lancaster Rose Club. After munching on chicken wings and meat balls most decided to turn in early.


A starting time of 3:30AM on Saturday came very early for hort and arrangers alike. They can sleep tomorrow, but today they need to have a quick start. Convention Chairman Brian Burley opened the doors to the prep rooms at 4:00AM. The coolers were opened and initial selections began as the 120 exhibitors donned their close-up glasses and dug into the work of a rose show. Grooming a rose for exhibition can be a daunting tedious task. Using miniature tools they poked and prodded, trimmed and snipped. One leaf at a time, one petal at a time, they meticulously inspected each detail. By 7:00AM some roses were set out to open just a bit more before the 9:30 close of entries, while others were put back into the cooler to keep them from opening any further. We can't forget the paperwork. Tags were completed by exhibitors as friends or family members made sure rose names were spelled correctly and class numbers were legible.

Meantime in other preparation rooms, oasis was slapped onto glass and ceramic containers. Inspiration was needed and now was the time. Arrangers mussed with form. A line was now developing and pattern started to emerge only to fail when skilled hands inserted a component that violated size or color requirements of the creator. Nevertheless, one arrangement after

another began to take shape. As time ticked toward the deadline arrangers tried not to hurry when they double checked their entry to comply with the schedule's class requirements.

The parade began about 8:45AM. There was no time for greeting other exhibitors in the hallway to the showroom now. This is business. Make the trip. Get the next entry. Make the next trip. The tension was building. Placement committee members were entering each rose at it's assigned place on the table. The parade didn't stop until Show Chairman Mark Miller sounded the alarm to close entries at 9:30. At that moment, it was all over. Smiles came back to the faces of the exhibitors. People stood around talking about the work of their hands over the last few hours. Some were a little upset about not getting more done. Others complained that one of their best specimens opened too quickly. But now all is water over the dam.

Over the course of Saturday morning judges assembled from across the nation. Twenty-eight of them took out their official







handiwork of the exhibitors. As the horticulture judges began their class assignments,

some judging teams turned the entry tags to the back to prohibit them from even seeing the rose name because it was written or printed by the exhibitor. Rose names would be reviewed for correctness later in the judging process.

Arrangement judges pulled chairs up to get their required eye level view of each arrangement. They discussed the elements, they referenced the schedule. They expressed their likes and dislikes. They arrived at consensus. The tag was marked with their decision. Over and over through the 142 arrangements they labored.

Clerks, like worker bees, transported winners to an area of the room where Mike Mitchell of Lancaster, Ohio was taking photographs, then it was on to the tabulation table where the winners were placed into the computer system that would house the official record of this year's competition. The well oiled machine of this year's business was grinding through prescribed procedures toward the show's conclusions. Each winner made its



way to a final resting place on the trophy table. And it was done.

As doors were unlocked to allow exhibitors and the public to view this year's edition of the "ARS National Mini", judges removed their magnifying glasses and closed their reference books.

One group of judges walked into the hall still debating the merits of a specimen in Class 14 and two arrangement judges were heard talking about the quality of the oriental entries. This show was over except for the congratulatory handshakes to winners and Monday morning quarterbacking from others who had entries that gained less favor of the judges.

A quick glance at the official winners list unmistakably shows that a blazing hot nearly arid summer in the South is no match for a good rose grower.



A circle almost instantly formed around Satish Prabhu of Columbia, SC as he stood in front of his 18 mini rose suite that was awarded the F. Harmon Saville Memorial Challenge Bowl.

Miniature roses selected by Satish included; Chattooga, Hilde, Joy, Magic Show, Renegade, Soroptimist International and Ty. As you may expect, they just couldn't be any better.



Sandy and Bob Lundberg of Bluffton, SC took home the Top Gun Award. Their winning mini-flora roses included; Abby's Angel, Cooper, Foolish Pleasure,

Shameless, Shawn Sease, Show Stopper, Tiffany Lynn, Unbridled and Whirlaway.






Next in the horticulture pecking order is Queen of Show which was awarded to Joy exhibited by John and Diana Fleek of Charleston, WV.



Princess (Erin Alonso) also went to the Fleek's, while Glenn and Donna Smith's Renegade was crowned King. The Smiths are from York Haven, Pa.

Miniflora's court was similarly split between north and south. Sandy and Bob Lundberg's Foolish Pleasure won Queen.







James Richardson of King, NC won King with Power Point.

Lynda Fleming of Wauwautosa, WI showed Rachael who walked away with the Princess ARS Bronze Award.

The photography tables were jammed with entries. Judges had split allegiance with half their score based on the rose quality and



half based on the photo technical and composition qualities. There were 7 classes of which 6 received Best of Class Awards. A beautiful photo of Sunglow (mf) was judged to be the Best of Show. Diane Sommers of Menomonee, WI won that award.

People on the other side of the show room were buzzing about a lady who was walking with a cane after hip replacement surgery just a few weeks before. I overheard someone jokingly ask her if she would be using her "lucky cane" next year. But Nancy

Redington's winning record could not be traced to luck.

Only skillful, meticulous implementation of clearly designed visions could result in the long list of honors she took home to Chambersburg, Pa. Despite the high number of arrangement entries (142)





Sandy Dixon presented Nancy all three medal certificates, ARS Gold, Silver and Bronze. They were three of the nine class trophies Nancy took home including the Miniature Artists Award, Mini-Princess Award, Miniature Keepsake Award and Miniature Rosecraft Certificate

Not to be eclipsed, Vijaya Prabhu of Columbia, SC took both ARS National trophies, the Ralph S. Moore Miniature



Arrangement Trophy as well as The J. Benjamin Williams Miniflora Arrangement Trophy. Vijaya used Kristin in her mini entry and Louisville Lady in the miniflora class.

Sandy Dixon, ARS Arrangement Chair reported the number of arrangements entered for the national trophy classes which have been as low as 3 or 4, such as in Hollywood, jumped this year to 14 entries and 8 entries in the classes for the Ralph S. Moore and J. Benjamin Williams, respectively. She said the competition was very demanding. Sandy noted that competition at highest levels shows dedication and true creativity. She concluded it was a wonderful place to learn what possibilities there are with different plant and man-made materials. Sandy said, "I for one was impressed, the arrangers of the ARS have much of which to be proud." The National Arrangement Chair was pleased that many attendees thought the rose arrangements excelled in both quantity and quality. Sandy summarized this year's event saying if the increased arrangement entry trend continues, future rose shows programs will need to give more space and emphasis to arrangements.

Gary Barlow of Fairborn, Ohio echoed Sandy's observations, saying the quality of the arrangements was outstanding adding that he wished the arrangements area had been larger to better accommodate the increased number of entries.

In all 32 exhibitors shared space on the trophy table. Winning roses flanked by beautiful Blenko glassware made a stunning table presentation of

color, form and beauty.

As we look at winning roses, a six pack of Joy (m) was on the trophy table, more than any other variety. Soroptomist International (m) was second with 5 wins.



Magic Show (m) and Whirlaway (mf) shared the 4 win category. Minifloras; Foolish Pleasure, Liberty Bell, Renegade and Sunglow each won 3 trophies.

While the showroom was being converted for the evening banquet several educational sessions were held down the hallway.

Educational Sessions

Carruth is trying to "right a wrong".

Award winning rose hybridizer, Tom Carruth traced historical breeding steps that resulted in the loss of rose fragrance. Using a video presentation of the hybridizing process he concluded that it will take many years to recover fragrance. Tom noted that crossing two fragrant roses doesn't guarantee a fragrant rose.

Len Pavuk, chairman of educational sessions, said the number of questions at the conclusion of Carruth's talk illustrated the intense interest of the standing room only audience.

Rose growing tools and potions

Gary Rankin, PhD, and Monica Valentovic, PhD presented a program on products for growing roses. Gary demonstrated

several garden tools. Hardware highlights included: the Leonard Soil Knife and a short-handled shovel. However, the "Water Saver", a meter that measures hose flow, and a Coast HL5 six LED light head lamp for working in the garden after dark or in the early morning before a show brought the most comments.

Monica talked about newer chemical fertilizers and pesticides available to rosarians for fertilizing and for preventing disease. She said Bayer's All-in-One soil drench is perfect for small garden growers who don't want to spray. It fertilizes and helps to prevent insects and fungal diseases. She was also excited about Avenger, an organic weed killer containing d-limonene, for controlling grasses and weeds around rose beds. Monica capped her presentation by giving us an easy recipe for treating powdery mildew (one tablespoon each of baking soda, cooking oil and Dawn dish washing detergent/gallon of water).

A Meeting of the Minds

The final Saturday afternoon program was a panel consisting of Tom Carruth, Bob Martin, Sandy Lundberg, George Meiling and Larry Peterson discussing "The Future of Testing Miniature and Miniflora Roses by ARS" and moderated by Jim Hering.

The prime topic was how to make the Award of Excellence more meaningful to hybridizers, nurserymen and the public.

Jim Hering reports that many expressed their thoughts about incorporating a "no spray" section into the AOE program. The public's demand for low maintenance plants brings new importance to testing roses for disease resistance.

The panel agreed that creating public educational materials about the significance of the AOE designation and promoting AOE winners to nurserymen and the public must be a high priority.

2012 Miniature National Banquet

The party began as people were greeted to the ballroom with the music of a pianist. Tables were decorated with rose arrangements from today's competition and yesterday's workshop. Dress up night was sprinkled with miniature rose boutonnieres, and broad smiles. At the door, exhibitors received their copy of the Official Winners List 18 page booklet documenting each winner, by class, by exhibitor and by rose variety.



Master of Ceremonies Brian Burley shared the platform with Show Chairman Mark Miller and Regional Director Dr. Jim Hering. They made several presentations including AOE winners to Tom Carruth for "You're the One" and "Diamond Eyes" and to Whit Wells for "Angelica Renae". Selected for the Hall of Fame were "Hot Tamale" and "X-Rated".

The short evening keynote from Tom Carruth challenged all to become involved in public gardens in their area. Citing recent declines in rose sales, Tom said the public garden is our best chance to promote and teach proper rose growing principles. Tom's address sounded a warning about the future of roses and called public gardens the vault in which we can protect and save our beloved hobby for our successors. He said nothing can compare to the picture of a youngster with mom and dad standing in front of a planting of colorful roses.

Pre-Convention Arrangements Workshop

Gary Barlow and Lew Shupe, along with guest instructors Sandy Dixon, Lee Hale, Mary Peterson and Ann Smith, conducted an arrangement workshop on the Thursday before the Convention...



Fifty-five people from across the nation crowded into the room. The course ranged from reviewing the backbones of arranging to the finer points that separate first place entries from second place entries. The work was intense. A mirage of materials flew in and out of mechanical holders as training examples were skillfully transformed from traditional to modern, from oriental to special class displays. Many of the student's arrangements were subsequently used for table decorations at Saturday night's banquet. The growing ranks of rose arrangers was evident at Saturday's competition.

Sunday's Garden Tour

A bright sunny Sunday morning needs to be enjoyed in a rose garden. That's what happened as two tour buses moved 75 people between the hotel, a crown gem of rose gardens, The Columbus Park of Roses, and The Ohio State University's Chadwick Arboretum. A progressive brunch featuring a continental breakfast at one venue and luscious hors d'oeuvres at the other venue was catered by University students.



George Meiling, expert in earth kind roses, answered questions about the northern test garden at the Park of Roses. Many enjoyed walking through the 13,000 plants, especially the heritage garden of older roses.

Tina Bozzuto talked about the Park of Roses Foundation and Stephanie Williams, the only public employee at the 13 acre park answered questions about spraying, pruning and maintenance.

When rose growers arrived at Chadwick, Master Gardener and Arboretum Director Mary Maloney and her capable volunteer staff guided them through the tirals beds of 700 colorful varieites of annuals.



Chadwick has 17 gardens including several enclaves of roses.

The Easy Elegance Rose Collection of earth-kind from Bailey

Nurseries is on trial here. Chadwick is the home of the John

Peter Minton Rose Garden.
